






OFFICIAL BALLOT GENERAL ELECTION

<p>CASTING A VOTE: To vote for the candidate of your choice, darken the oval () to the LEFT of the candidate's name. If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the Election Official and obtain another. Do not attempt to erase any marks made in error.</p> <p>WRITE-IN: To vote for a write-in candidate, write the name of the candidate on the line provided and darken the oval. A write-in vote will NOT be counted unless the vote is for a DECLARED write-in candidate.</p> <p>STRAIGHT PARTY VOTING: You may vote a Straight Party Ballot for all the candidates of the party of your choice by darkening the oval for the party in the STRAIGHT PARTY section. Your voting mark will give every candidate of that party a vote.</p> <p>SPLIT-TICKET VOTING: You may vote a Straight Party Ticket by marking ONE of the party choices and then voting for individual candidates of your choice in any other party OR you may vote for individual candidates for your choice in each office.</p> <p>PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS: A ballot cast for the named candidates for President and Vice President of the United States is considered a ballot cast for the slate of presidential electors nominated by that political party or independent candidate.</p> <p>JUDICIAL RETENTION QUESTIONS: If you wish to vote on a judicial retention question, you must make another voting mark on the appropriate place on the back of this ballot.</p>
